Koonara Angel's Peak Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon 2013

100% Coonawarra

The name 'Angels Peak' is in reference to the winemakers folklore "Angel's Share" which is the portion that evaporates from our French Oak barrels. At it's peak at 18 months, 10% of the wine may have been "gifted", leaving the remaining wine more concentrated and age worthy.

This wine has huge colour and decanting this wine for an hour will allow you to see the true depth of flavour, but also show you that this wine is almost unique at this price, in that it will get better for 20 years. No residual sugar, below organic levels of sulphur, and organically grown.
